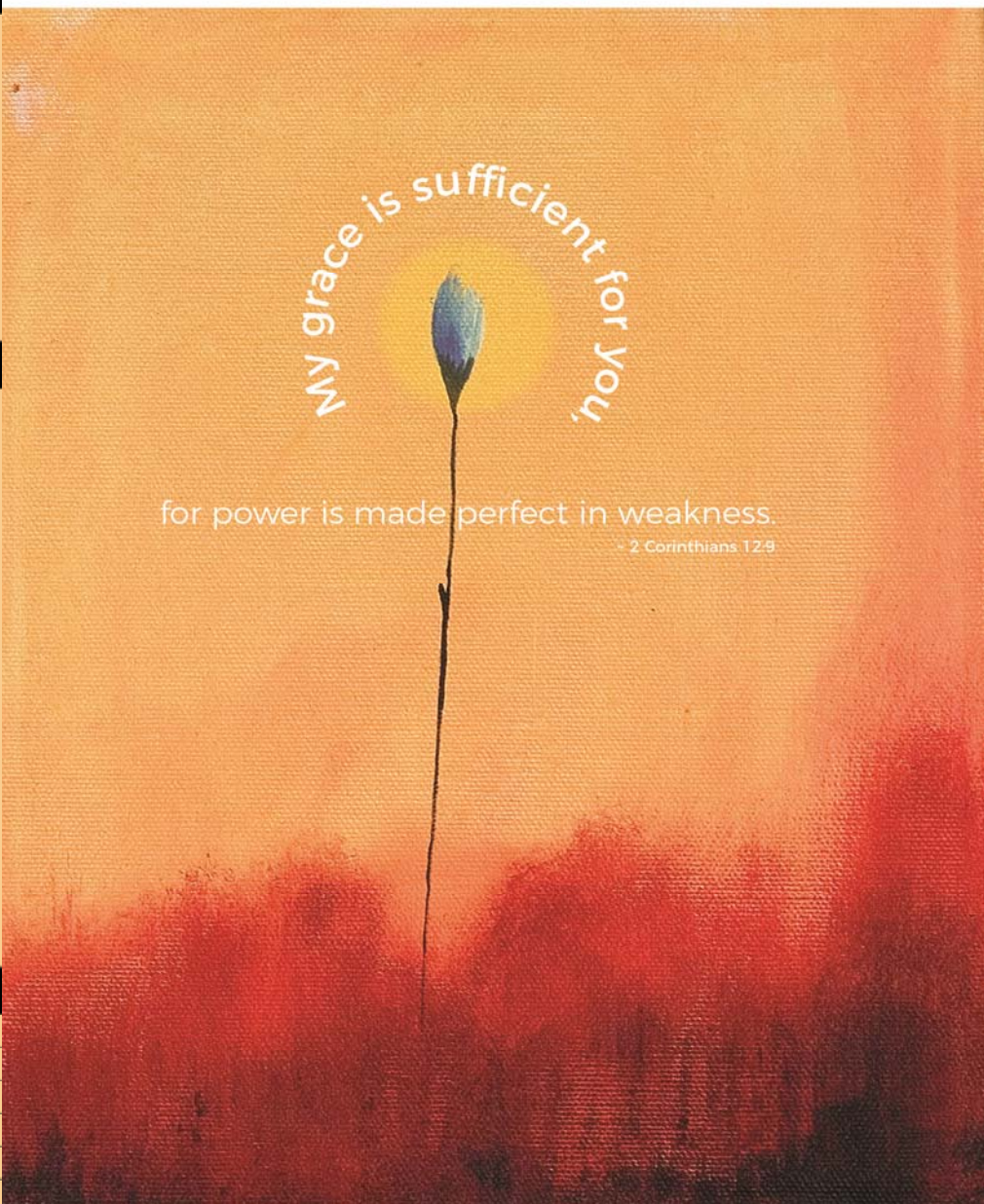

Lifeline of Listening Friends-Suicide Loss Support Groups

Grieving the loss of a loved one is one of the hardest things we have to do in life and it is best done with the help of others. **"Lifeline of Listening Friends"** is a bereavement program of **St. Joseph Parish O'Hara** that offers support group programs for those who are grieving the loss of a loved one. Insightful DVD's, selected resources materials and most important time spent with listening friends, are used to help guide people through the stages of grief and along the healing pathway to a new normal. Grieving the loss of a loved one who has completed suicide however, requires a support group dedicated to addressing their unique emotional pain and grief.

Listening Friends has four **"Grief & Loss Support Groups"** specifically for people whose loved one has died from suicide. Each support group meets monthly at various parish locations throughout the **Diocese of Pittsburgh**, and people are welcome to attend any of our meetings and at any time. In addition, all of our Support Group Facilitators have been trained by the **American Foundation for Suicide Prevention** to help people deal with the emotional pain of a suicide death.
